TWO NEW MEMBERS ADDED TO HOOP HISTORIANS



Mike Bailey and **Dennis Bracco** were elected as members of the Hoop Historians at the group's Annual Business Meeting earlier this month in Houston

Bailey is the Associate Executive Director of the Illinois Basketball Coaches Association and previously served as President of the group. As a head high school basketball coach, Bailey achieved over 600 victories, won 16 regional championships and three sectional titles.

Bracco, who was selected as an Honorary Member, spent 34 years as an accomplished high school and college basketball official. Dennis worked Division1 ball for 28 years in Conference USA, the Mid-Continent, Horizon, Sun Belt, Ohio Valley and Big Ten Conferences. Dennis worked games in NIT and all three divisions of the NCAA Tournament.


HOOP HISTORIAN LARRY HOLLEY 1945-2022



We have learned of the passing of Hoop Historian Larry Holley. Holley had 51 years of experience as a

basketball coach and had retired from William Jewell College in Missouri in 2019, where the basketball court is named after him in his honor. Holley's teams won 918 games, advanced to 14 national tournaments and played in four NAIA Final Fours. Holley, who joined the Hoop Historians in 2021, was a contributor on the group's monthly Zoom calls.
