RECORD TURNOUT FOR WOMENS HOOP EVENT



It's pretty safe to say that the Hoop Historians are just about everywhere. Hoop Historian Mike Bailey and his daughter Kellyn attended the pre-season women's basketball scrimmage between the Iowa Hawkeyes and the DePaul Blue Demons which attracted 55,646 spectators - the largest event ever for women's college basketball. "The Crossover at Kinnic" was held at the University of Iowa's football stadium and exceeded the previous attendance record for a women's basketball event by more than 26,000 people than the previous record.

RETURN OF THE CATHOLIC LEAGUE RIVALRY



High school basketball in the Chicago Catholic League over the past 100 years has provided great players and rivalries. Two schools, Weber and Gordon Tech, were separated by only five miles and built a ferocious competition over fifty years of play as two Catholic boys only secondary schools. The neighborhood battle ended in 1999 when Weber High School closed and Tech would later be Gordon renamed a dozen years later. This rivalry was recollected at the Basketball Museum of Illinois this past month. A number of Hoop Historians were present for the reunion, as they were graduates of the two schools. John Genova, John McCann and Kevin McCann were students at Gordon Tech and Joe Makowski studied at Weber. Around 100 alumni from the two schools attended the event. Former Duke basketball Coach Mike Krzyzewski, who played for Weber, made a cameo video appearance.
