CAL DILWORTH 1931 - 2018



Historian Cal Hoop Dilworth passed away on his 87<sup>th</sup> birthday, November 8. Cal was the former Director of Detroit's Master's Sports and Recreation Program, a group that he founded at age 50 and managed for twenty years. former Harlem Globetrotter, Cal played for Team USA abroad in seven countries. He was inducted into five different Hall of Fames and sponsored an Endowed Basketball Scholarship at Wayne State University. Cal started basketball participation in the Huntsman World Games in 1986 Senior organizing and bringing teams to play there on an annual basis, and played in the event for more than 30 years. Cal was a long-time member of the National Basketball Coaches Association and attended every Final Four from 1989 to 2017. For his many accomplishments, Dilworth was recognized in 2011 by the Hoop Historians for his years of service and being an ambassador to the sport of basketball.


recently spent an interesting 24 hours. While on a business trip, Hersh had breakfast in Hong
