Hoop Historian Bill Carsley has been announced as a Class of 2008 inductee into the DePaul University Hall of Fame. Along with five other



individual student-athletes and one team, the long time booster and athletic alum will be honored with the Robert C. Hamilton Special Service award for his tremendous leadership and passion that he has exhibited in support of Blue Demon Athletics.

Carsley, who received his Bachelors, Masters and Law Degrees from the Chicago college, has been very active in university affairs as Chair of the 1300-plus member President's Club and has served on various Athletic Advisory Boards.

A former coach and teacher in Chicagoland, Bill recently retired as a lawyer with the city of Chicago. His passion for sports extends outside his alma mater as he is a long-time season ticket holder for the Cubs, Bears, De Paul basketball and Northwestern football.

Carsley, who attended his 100th Final Four game last year in Atlanta, is the third Hoop Historian to be enshrined in a Hall of Fame in the past year. Kevin McCann was named to the Illinois Basketball Coaches Association Hall of Fame last summer as a Friend of Basketball and Fred Allman will join that same Hall of Fame later this year as an official.
