DENNIS MISHKO INDUCTED INTO HALL OF FAME

Historian gooH Dennis Mishko was inducted into Kevstone the College Hall of Fame in October. An educator for 36 years, he began his coaching career



at Keystone in 1972 and for 25 years mentored one of the most successful programs in the college's history, coaching the mens' basketball team to a 520-160 record, the highest win total of any coach of any sport at Keystone.

During his coaching tenure, the Giants captured two Region XIX basketball championships and earned two trips to the NJCAA National Championships (1986, 1989). The two-time Region XIX Coach of the Year came within one victory of a national crown in 1986 when his Giants advanced to the national title game.

In addition to serving as basketball coach, Mishko also led the men's soccer program from 1972-1992. During that span, his teams won 122 games, making him the winningest soccer coach in Keystone history.

Mishko also served the Keystone athletic department as the director of athletics for six years.

Today, Mishko still serves as a professor at Keystone in the Division of Natural Sciences and Mathematics and as the head coach of the boy's varsity soccer team at Abington Heights High School.
