## HONORARY MEMBERS TO BE CONSIDERED

For the first time, the Hoop Historians will consider Honorary Members to their delegation. To qualify for an Honorary Membership, an individual must have distinguished themselves by giving their time and service to promoting goodwill through basketball (current or past employment), or have been recognized for their contributions to the game of basketball (awards, appointments, or meritorious service to the game). An individual must also have shared their past basketball experiences with the Hoop Historians. Individuals to be considered for Honorary Membership in the Hoop Historians, must be nominated by a current Hoop Historians member and receive a 75% affirmative vote of the eligible members present at the annual meeting. A paragraph summarizing the reason for Honorary Membership must accompany consideration nomination request and be submitted to the Hoop Historians no later than March 1 of each year in order for the nomination to be voted upon at the annual meeting.
