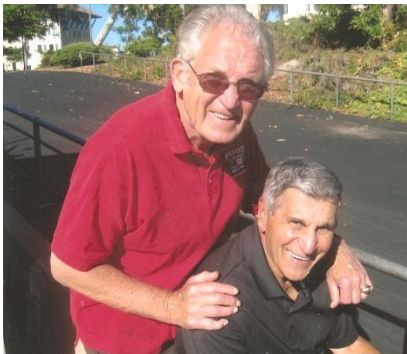

COMINGS & GOINGS



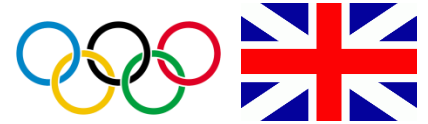
