HOOP HISTORIANS: BY THE NUMBERS....

- ❖ There are 42 full members of the Hoop Historians and six Honorary Members.
- ❖ The group has representatives from 12 different states.
- ❖ The 42 full members have attended a collective 822 Final Fours, dating back to 1958.
- ❖ The group first assembled in 1999 with ten charter members.
- ❖ Since 2000 the group has seen early round games of the NCAA Tournament in more than 30 different cities.
- ❖ The 42 full members have attended 3,906 games of the NCAA Tournament (all rounds).
- ❖ 15 full members have been to 25 or more Final Fours.
- ❖ The group has a unique requirement for membership by having to attend at least three Final Fours, being a Friend of the Hoop Historians for at least a year and getting approved by 75% of the membership.
