EIGHT CITIES BID FOR FUTURE FINAL FOURS

The NCAA announced that eight cities are finalists for the four Final Four sites, running from 2017-2020: Atlanta, Indianapolis, Minneapolis, New Orleans. North Texas. Phoenix/Glendale. San Antonio and Saint Louis. Upcoming Final Fours will be played in North Texas this year; Indianapolis in 2015 and Houston in 2016. Two cities would like to host the event in their brand new stadiums, as the Minnesota Vikings Stadium is scheduled to open in the fall of 2016 and the Atlanta Falcons Stadium is planned to open in 2017. Both venues are also bidding to host upcoming Super Bowls. Indianapolis has been a traditional Final Four city, as Nap Town has hosted the finals four times from 1997-2010. Two Hoop Historians favorite cities. Orleans and San Antonio are back in the mix after each hosting twice This year's host since 2003. Cowboys Stadium would like to earn a second Final Four. Saint Louis looks to gain their second Final Four and Glendale/Phoenix is bidding for their first. The NCAA will announce Final Four sites as well as preliminary round locations for 2016-2018 in November.
